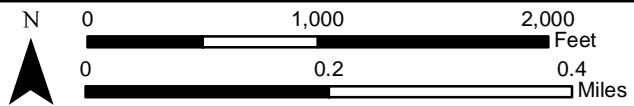
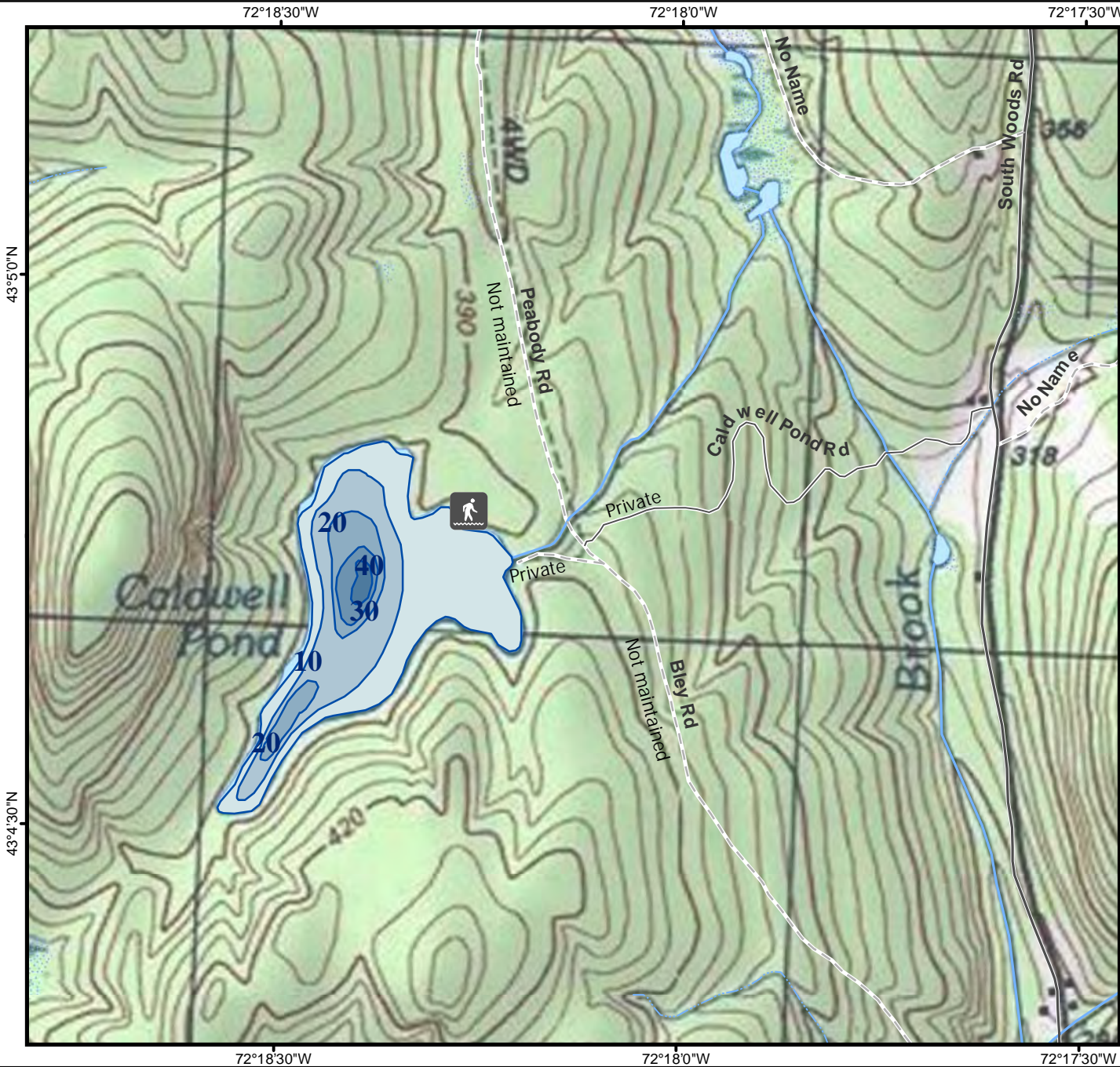

Directions: Rt 12A to Gilsum Rd to South Woods Rd (see next page)

Directions to Caldwell Pond

From Keene, take Rt 12a North. Take right onto Gilsum Road.

Take left onto South Woods Road and travel 2.4 miles.

There is a Public Access to Caldwell Pond sign on the west side of the road.

Total distance from public access sign to pond is 1.3 miles



Walk ~20 minutes up this 4WD trail to the following junction
(as of 6-2010, the left you take in the picture below that had a bridge crossing the stream
has been washed out; you can still get around the washout but not with a 4-wheeler or
dirt bike; see 2nd and 3rd picture below):





Go left on the new trail for 15 more minutes. You will a sign directing you to the access 100m further past the sign (as of 6-10, sign in below picture is no longer there). If you reach the outlet of the pond you have gone too far.

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You are now at the pond:



This is the only area that is not posted and at which you can access the pond.
