6. (a) Summary of what the rule says and the effect of the rule on those regulated:

The Department is proposing to:

- Amend Fis 301.07 by inserting Fis 301.07(k) to allow the use of more than one guide for permittees taking moose under Hunt of a Lifetime;

- Make changes to Fis 1100 relative to the information on license and permits by proposing to:

Readopt with amendment:

Fis 1101.01 (Multi-license Form) to add additional licenses to the multiform and information required,

Fis 1101.02 (Complimentary Licenses for Citizens over 68) to add additional information to the form,

Fis 1101.03 (Lifetime Licenses) to add additional licenses to the multiform and information required,

Fis 1101.05 (Complimentary for Certain Disabled Persons) and Fis 1101.06 (Temporary License – Active Duty Armed Forces and Coast Guard) to add information to the form;

Fis 1101.07 (Permanently Disabled Veterans License) amend the rule to clarify the person who must fill out a portion of the form by changing it from the veteran’s service officer to a representative from the Veterans Administration and to clarify time of service eligibility dates by referencing Per 701.02,

Fis 1102.03 (Hunting from a Motor Vehicle), Fis 1103.01 (Trapping Licenses)

and 1103.02 (Fur Buyer's License), Fis 1104.01 (Special License for Persons over 65 on Public Aid), Fis 1104.02 (Special for Blind Persons), Fis 1104.06 (Complimentary Fishing Permit), Fis 1106.02 (Taxidermy License), and Fis 1106.05 (Training Dogs) to add information on the form, and Fis 1108.01 (Duplicate Licenses and Tags) to remove the signature of the licensing agent.

Amend Fis 301.07 effective 5/28/08 (Doc #9163), as amended effective 6/5/10 (Doc #9720-A & 9720-B), by inserting new paragraph (k), and renumbering remaining paragraphs, so fis 301.07 (k) reads as follows:

(k) Notwithstanding (e) above, a permittee taking moose under the provisions of RSA 208:1-aa may use additional guides to assist in carrying out such hunt as necessary for the safe and successful completion of the hunt.

Readopt with amendment Fis 1101.01 effective 9/28/04 (Doc #8183), and as amended effective 9/12/2010 (Doc #9543), to read as follows:

(a) The multi-license form shall be used for the following:

- h. Bear;

m. Saltwater fishing; and

(2) Resident licenses for:

- a. Clam, ages 6 – 68; and

b. Oyster, ages 6 – 68; and

(3) Nonresident licenses for:

~~a. One day fishing;~~

~~eb.~~ Seven day fishing;

~~ec.~~ Small game hunting; and

~~ed.~~ Small game hunting – 3 day;

(4) The following donations:

(b) A resident applicant shall provide, in addition to the information required by RSA 214:8, the following:

(1) The applicant's:

a. Height and weight;

b. Hair color;

e. Home or personal cell phone number; and

(2) Previous archery license number or certificate date;

(3) Previous firearm license number or certificate date;

- (4) Current year hunting license number if purchasing a separate muzzleloader, pheasant, bear **or turkey** license;
 - (5) Mailing address;
 - (6) A response as to whether the licensee intends to hunt migratory game birds;
 - (7) Driver's license number;
 - (8) The date and time in which the 1-day fishing license is valid;** and
 - (98)** Signature of applicant, subject to the penalties for making unsworn false statements under RSA 641:3.
- (c) A nonresident applicant shall provide, in addition to the information specified in (b), the dates and times in which the ~~1-day~~, 3-day, and 7-day fishing licenses and the 3-day small game licenses are valid.
- (d) The fee for the pheasant license shall be ~~\$15.00 and increases to \$25.00 on January 1, 2010.~~

Readopt with amendment Fis 1101.02 and 1101.03, effective 9-28-04 (Doc #8183), to read as follows:

Fis 1101.02 Complimentary for Citizens Over 68.

- (a) The complimentary license for persons over 68 shall include the following licenses:
 - (1) Fishing;
 - (2) Combination hunting and fishing;
 - (3) Muzzleloader;
 - (4) Clam, oyster, and clamworm; and/or
 - (5) Archery.
- (b) The applicant shall provide in addition to the information required by RSA 214:8, the following:
 - (1) The applicant's date of birth; ~~and~~

 - (3) Previous firearm license number or certificate date;**
 - (4) Driver's license number; and**
 - (25)** The signature of applicant, subject to penalties for making unsworn false statements under RSA 641:3.

Fis 1101.03 Lifetime License.

(a) An applicant for a lifetime hunting, fishing ~~or~~, combination hunting and fishing license, **archery, muzzleloader or annual deer crossbow** under RSA 214:9-c **and RSA 214:9-cc** shall submit a copy of their valid New Hampshire driver's license or non driver's picture ID as evidence of their age.

(b) An applicant shall provide, in addition to the information required by RSA 214:8, the applicant's:

(1) Date of birth;

(2) Height;

(3) Street and mailing address; ~~and~~

(4) Previous archery license number or certificate date;

(5) Previous firearm license number or certificate date;

(6) Copy of their valid New Hampshire driver's license or non driver's picture identification;

(7) Telephone number; and

(4)(8) The signature of applicant signed subject to penalties for making unsworn false statements under RSA 641:3.

(c) An applicant for a minor lifetime license shall be issued as a gift certificate, using the lifetime gift certificate application form. The applicant shall provide, in addition to the information required by RSA 214:8, the applicant's:

(1) Date of birth;

(2) Height;

(3) Street and mailing address;

(4) Telephone number;

(5) Purchaser's name;

(6) Purchaser's address and

(7) Purchaser's telephone number.

(d) Beginning January 1, 2011, persons holding a lifetime fishing or combination license may request a lifetime limited annual saltwater license to take saltwater smelt, saltwater shad, or saltwater

salmonids pursuant to RSA 214:9-c VII-a by providing the information in (b), with the exception of (b)(4) through (6).

Readopt Fis 1101.04, effective 9-28-04 (Doc #8183), to read as follows:

Fis 1101.04 Honorary Hunting and Fishing.

(a) Applicants for nonresident honorary hunting and fishing licenses as described in RSA 214:13-a shall make their request in writing and include a copy of a certificate of completion of a hunter education course or previous license as required under RSA 214:23-a.

(b) A nonresident honorary hunting and fishing license applicant shall provide, in addition to the information required by RSA 214:8, the applicant's:

- (1) Date of birth;
- (2) Height and weight;
- (3) Color of hair;
- (4) Title, position or membership status; and
- (5) The signature of applicant, subject to penalties for making unsworn false statements under RSA 641:3.

(c) To be eligible for a nonresident honorary hunting and fishing license, outdoor writers shall be listed as an active member of either New England Outdoor Writers Association (NEOWA) or the Outdoor Writers of America Association (OWAA) or be on the staff of a newspaper, magazine or newsletter, electronic or traditional print as well as writers for outdoor, hunting and fishing related radio and television programming.

Readopt with amendment Fis 1101.05 – 1101.07, effective 9-28-04 (Doc #8183), to read as follows:

Fis 1101.05 Complimentary for Certain Disabled Persons.

(a) An applicant for a paraplegic hunting and fishing license shall submit a letter from a physician verifying the applicant as disabled as described in RSA 214:13-b or 214:13-c.

(b) An applicant for a paraplegic hunting and fishing license or fishing license shall provide in addition to the information required by RSA 214:8, the following:

- (1) Date of birth;
- (2) Hair color;
- (3) Height;

(4) Weight; ~~and~~

(5) Mailing Address;

(6) Telephone number; and

~~(57)~~ The signature of applicant signed subject to penalties for making unsworn false statements under RSA 641:3.

Fis 1101.06 Temporary License – Active Duty Armed Forces and Coast Guard.

(a) Applicants for a temporary license pursuant to RSA 214:3 shall present duty orders as proof of eligibility.

(b) Applicants shall provide in addition to the information required by RSA 214:8, the applicant's:

(1) Date of birth;

(2) Hair color;

(3) Height and weight;

(4) Effective dates for active duty;

(5) Military ID number; ~~and~~

(6) Telephone number; and

~~(67)~~ Signature signed subject to penalties for making unsworn false statements under RSA 641:3.

Fis 1101.07 Permanently Disabled Veterans License.

(a) Applicants for a permanent disabled veteran's license as provided in RSA 214:13 shall submit an application on which the top portion is completed by the applicant and the lower portion has been completed by the ~~veteran's service officer~~ **a representative from the Veterans Administration.**

(b) The applicant shall provide, in addition to the information required by RSA 214:8, the applicant's:

(1) Date of birth;

(2) Hair color;

(3) Weight and height; and

(4) Signature, signed under the penalty for making unsworn false statements pursuant to RSA 641:3.

- (c) The ~~veteran's service officer~~ **representative from the Veterans Administration** shall provide:
- (1) The applicant's branch of military service;
 - (2) Type of discharge;
 - (3) Name of war or police action the United States was engaged in during the applicant's time of service **eligibility dates as specified in Per 701.02**;
 - (4) Indicate whether the applicant was totally and permanently disabled; and
 - (5) Signature, signed under the penalty for making unsworn false statements pursuant to RSA 641:3.

Adopt Fis 1101.08 to read as follows:

Fis 1101.08 Permanent Disabled Crossbow Permit.

(a) Applicants for a permanent disabled crossbow permit as provided in RSA 207:10-c shall submit an application on which the top portion is completed by the applicant and the lower portion has been completed by the applicants physician. The definition of physician for this purpose shall include nurse practitioners licensed in New Hampshire.

- (b) The applicant shall provide, in addition to the information required by RSA 214:8, the applicant's:
- (1) Date of birth;
 - (2) Hair color;
 - (3) Weight and Height;
 - (4) Mailing address;
 - (5) Telephone number; and
 - (6) The signature of the applicant signed subject to penalties for making false statements under RSA 641:3.

- (c) The physician shall provide:
- (1) Physician's name, address and telephone number;
 - (2) A description of the permanent physical disability;
 - (3) An indication of how the permanent physical disability prohibits the applicant from using a conventional or compound bow; and
 - (4) Physician's signature and date.

Readopt Fis 1102.01 and 1102.02, effective 9-28-04 (Doc #8183), to read as follows:

Fis 1102.01 NH Special Wildlife Permit.

(a) Unlicensed landowners, minors, hunting licensees who have lost the deer tag, or hunters holding the license described in Fis 1101.02 and Fis 1101.03, or any person possessing moose or other protected wildlife, shall be required to obtain a NH Special Wildlife Permit from a department conservation officer in order to possess wildlife.

(b) Applicants shall provide the following:

- (1) The type and number of the license,
- (2) The species to be possessed or transported out of state;
- (3) Where transported and the date of such transportation;
- (4) Status of permittee such as:
 - a. Landowner;
 - b. Minor; or
 - c. Person holding a complimentary over 68 license or a lifetime license;
- (5) The date and town where wildlife was killed;
- (6) The sex, weight and place of storage of wildlife;
- (7) The name, address and signature of the person who killed the wildlife, or in the case of a minor, the signature of the accompanying adult;
- (8) Dated signature, signed subject to the penalty for making unsworn false statements pursuant to RSA 641:3.
- (9) The cause of death; and
- (10) Acknowledgment receipt of the wildlife species received relieving the New Hampshire fish and game department and its employees of any liabilities relative to the suitability for human consumption.

Fis 1102.02 NH Wildlife Permit for Wildlife Killed by a Motor Vehicle.

(a) Residents who have accidentally killed wildlife shall obtain a NH wildlife permit for wildlife killed by a motor vehicle from a department conservation officer in order to possess said wildlife.

- (b) An applicant shall provide the following:
 - (1) Name and address;
 - (2) Telephone number;
 - (3) Species and sex of wildlife killed;
 - (4) The date of accidental kill; and
 - (5) The wildlife management unit, town and exact location of kill;
- (c) The yellow copy of the permit shall be kept with the meat.
- (d) The permit shall expire 6 months from the date of kill. Extensions shall be granted by calling 271-3361.

Readopt with amendment Fis 1102.03, effective 9-28-04 (Doc #8183), to read as follows:

Fis 1102.03 Hunting From a Motor Vehicle.

(a) An applicant for permit to hunt from a motor vehicle as specified in RSA 207:7-a, shall provide, in addition to the information in RSA 214:8, the following:

- (1) The applicant's:
 - a. Date of birth;
 - b. Hair color; and
 - c. Height and weight; ~~and~~
 - d. Mailing address;**
 - e. Telephone number; and**
 - f. The signature of applicant signed subject to penalties for making unsworn false statements under RSA 641:3.**
- (2) The number of the applicant's current hunting license.

Readopt Fis 1102.04, effective 9-28-04 (Doc #8183), to read as follows:

Fis 1102.04 Baiting Wildlife.

(a) A person may bait wildlife in accordance with RSA 207:3-d on lands other than their own, only after obtaining permission in writing to do so from the owner or occupant of the land where baiting is to be done. Said permission shall be a permit to bait wildlife.

(b) Blank permits to bait wildlife shall be obtained from the fish and game department or a conservation officer. Said permits shall be made out in quadruplicate.

(c) Prior to baiting, the permittee shall distribute the copies of the permit as follows:

- (1) The white copy shall be retained by the permittee;
- (2) The canary copy shall be left with the landowner;
- (3) The pink copy with a USGS map or copy showing the specific location of said bait site shall be presented to or mailed to the conservation officer in whose district baiting is to be done; and
- (4) The goldenrod copy shall be mailed to the NH fish and game department law enforcement division, 11 Hazen Drive, Concord, NH 03301.

(d) No bait shall be placed unless the pink copy with map has been presented to the conservation officer in hand or until 3 days has elapsed after date of postmark, if mailed.

(e) The permittee to bait wildlife under RSA 207:3-d shall include the following:

- (1) The date of issuance;
- (2) The name of the permittee;
- (3) The address of the permittee;
- (4) The telephone number of the permittee;
- (5) The location of the land where baiting is to be allowed and described by town, road, and property name or White Mountain National Forest district and unit if on state managed lands;
- (6) Directions to the exact location;
- (7) Name and address of landowner printed in a legible manner;
- (8) Telephone number of the landowner;
- (9) A blank for the issuing landowners to state stipulations, if any, to placing bait; and
- (10) The signature of the landowner/lessee or, if public land, of the proper authority.

(f) All permits to bait wildlife shall expire December 31 following the date of issuance.

(g) A permit to bait wildlife shall be valid for a single permittee only and shall have only that permittee's name entered on the permit.

(h) Each person placing bait shall post at each bait site, in a clearly visible manner, an identification sign made of durable material at least 3 inches by 6 inches in size which shall bear the name and address of the person placing said bait.

(i) Persons placing bait for bear shall comply with the signing provisions contained in Fis 301.06 (c)

Readopt Fis 1102.06, effective 9-28-04 (Doc #8183), as amended effective 3-1-05 (Doc #8295), to read as follows:

Fis 1102.06 Bear Guide Permit.

(a) A New Hampshire licensed guide shall make application to the New Hampshire fish and game department on Form F&G 401A by providing the following:

- (1) Name, address, telephone number of applicant;
- (2) New Hampshire hunting license number;
- (3) New Hampshire hunting guide license number;
- (4) Type of guiding whether with dogs, over bait, stalking or still hunting; and
- (5) Signature of applicant, signed subject to the penalties for making unsworn false statements under RSA 641:3.

(b) Requests for bear guide permits shall only be accepted after April 15 of any year.

Readopt Fis 1102.07, effective 9-28-04 (Doc #8183), to read as follows:

Fis 1102.07 Guided Bear Transportation Tags.

(a) Guided bear transportation tags, which are divided into 2 sections, shall be completed as follows:

- (1) The hunter shall provide the following on Section A:
 - a. Name of hunter killing the bear;
 - b. Address of hunter;
 - c. Hunting license number, including the prefix;
 - d. Name of the guide;
 - e. Guide's license number;

- f. Date and time of kill;
- g. Town of kill; and
- h. Signature of the hunter, signed subject to the penalties for making unsworn false statements under RSA 641:3; and

(2) The guide shall provide the following on Section B:

- a. Name of the hunter killing the bear;
- b. Address of hunter;
- c. Hunting license number including prefix;
- d. Name of guide;
- e. Guide's license number;
- f. Town of kill;
- g. Sex of bear; and

(a) Applicants for a resident or non-resident hunting or fishing guide license under RSA 215:2 shall make application and provide, in addition to the information required by RSA 214:8, the following:

(1) The applicant's:

a. Mailing address;

b. Telephone number;

c. Date of birth;

d. Gender;

e. Height;

f. Weight;

g. Hair color;

(2) The business name, address and telephone number, if applicable;

(3) An indication if the applicant has previously been a guide and if so, in what state, for how many years, and what was the last year the applicant was licensed as a guide;

(4) An indication if the applicant will be using boats and canoes while guiding;

(5) A statement explaining how much experience the applicant has with handling boats, motors, and canoes and familiarity with map and compass;

(6) Documentation that the applicant has taken and successfully completed a hunter safety course if applying for a hunting guide license;

(7) Documentation that the applicant is currently certified in, at minimum, a basic first aid course and cardiopulmonary resuscitation course;

(8) An indication if the applicant has been convicted of any violation or crime within the last 7 years, the nature of any convictions and in what state;

(9) The signature of applicant subject to the penalties for making unsworn false statements under RSA 641:3.

(b) The fee for the resident fishing guide license or resident hunting guide license for persons over 65 years of age, pursuant to RSA 215:5 II, shall be \$5.00.

(c) Applicants for a renewal of a guides license shall not be required to provide the information specified in (a)(3), (4), (5) (6) and (8).

Readopt Fis 1106.04, effective 9-28-04 (Doc #8183), to read as follows:

Fis 1106.04 Wholesale Venison License.

(a) Each applicant for the wholesale venison licenses under RSA 212:30-d shall make application which includes the following:

(1) The applicant's name and address;

(2) The applicant's telephone number;

(3) The applicant's business name and address; and

(4) The signature of applicant subject to the penalties for making unsworn false statements under RSA 641:3.

Readopt with amendment Fis 1106.05, effective 9-28-04 (Doc #8183), to read as follows:

Fis 1106.05 Training Dogs.

(a) Applicants for a permit to train dogs under RSA 207:12-a shall make application which shall include:

(1) The name, address and telephone number of the applicant;

(2) Applicants date of birth;

~~(23)~~ The number and breed of dogs to be trained, the current and valid dog license numbers or the kennel license number, and the name of the town where licensed;

~~(34)~~ The species of animal or bird which will be utilized for the training of the dogs;

~~(45)~~ The time of day and day of the week proposed for such training;

~~(56)~~ The type and number of the hunting license held by the applicant;

~~(67)~~ The individual frequencies to be utilized while training; and

~~(78)~~ The applicant's signature, signed subject to the penalties for making unsworn false statements under RSA 641:3.

Fis 1107.01 Multi-license Form – Electronic Issuance.

(a) The multi-form license described in Fis 1101.01 may be issued electronically by accessing the department web site.

(b) An applicant shall provide, in addition to the information required by RSA 214:8 and Fis 1101.01, the following:

(1) An email address; and

(2) Credit card information to include:

a. Card type;

- b. Card number,
- c. Expiration date; and
- d. A confirmation of the card holder information.

(c) License confirmation and an internet link to the PDF file for license printing shall be sent to the email address.

Readopt with amendment Fis 1108.01, effective 9-28-04 (Doc #8183), to read as follows:

PART Fis 1108 DUPLICATE LICENSES AND TAGS

Fis1108.01 Duplicate Licenses and Tags.

- (a) All duplicate licenses shall be issued on the license form described in Fis 1101.01 and Fis 1107.01 in the case of an online license and shall be a true copy of the original license.
- (b) Duplicate licenses shall be issued by the original issuing agent of the lost license if he is able to verify original sale or the Fish and Game Department.
- (c) In addition to items described in Fis 1101.01 or Fis 1107.01, the duplicate license shall include:
 - (1) ~~T~~ the lost license number, ~~and~~
 - (2) ~~Signature of the issuing agent.~~
- (d) The fee, in accordance with RSA 214:9-b and agent fee in accordance with RSA 214:15 shall be per license form.

Readopt Fis 1109.01, effective 9-28-04 (Doc #8183), to read as follows:

Fis 1109.01 Written Permission Sufficient. Where no permit or license forms exist, a written statement, signed by the director or his or her designated agent, shall be sufficient to authorize activities which the director has statutory authority to regulate.
