RSA 214:13-a Fis 1101.04

When applying for a Nonresident Honorary License the following are requirements:

- If you are requesting a hunting license you will need proof of hunting, we require a previously held hunting license from any state, province of Canada. Or a Hunter Safety Certificate from any State Authorized Hunter Education Program.
- To be eligible for a nonresident honorary hunting and fishing license, outdoor writers shall be listed as an active member of either New England Outdoor Writers Association (NEOWA) or the Outdoor Writers of America Association (OWAA) or be on the staff of a newspaper, magazine or newsletter, electronic or traditional print as well as writers for outdoor, hunting and fishing related radio and television programming.
