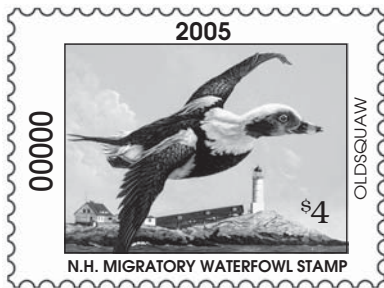


# 2005 New Hampshire Migratory Waterfowl Stamp

“Shoals Squaw”, by James Collins of Plaistow, N.H., was selected to appear on the 2005 New Hampshire Migratory Waterfowl Stamp. The acrylic-on-board painting features an oldsquaw (now called the long-tailed duck) flying over White Island at the Isles of Shoals, off New Hampshire’s coastline.

While no print will be offered this year, collector-quality stamps are available. Proceeds from the sale of the stamps go to the Waterfowl Conservation Fund.
