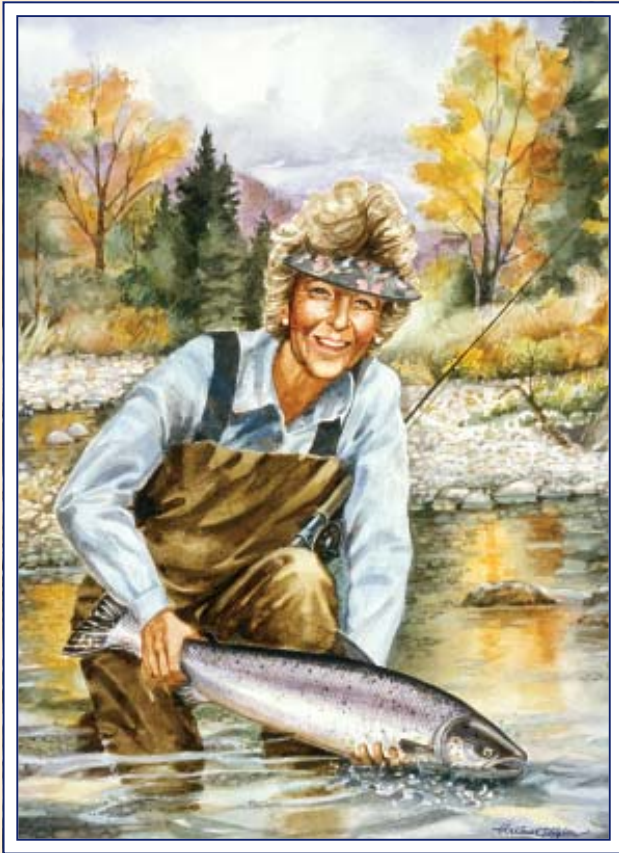

### The Merrimack River Anadromous Fish Restoration Program

In 1969, the Merrimack River Anadromous Fish Restoration Program began. It is a cooperative effort of the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department, Massachusetts Division of Fisheries and Wildlife, Massachusetts Division of Marine Fisheries, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, the National Marine Fisheries Service and the U.S. Forest Service. In addition to Atlantic salmon, the restoration program includes American shad and river herring, both of which are again returning to the river to spawn.

### About The Artist

Arthur Taylor, of Lincoln, Maine, is well-known for his paintings of Atlantic salmon and their environments. His work is highly respected in the sporting art world.

### About Joan Wulff

Joan Salvato Wulff was a tournament caster from 1937 to 1960, winning 17 national and one international casting titles. Author of three books, Joan also wrote a casting column for Fly Rod & Reel Magazine for 22 years. She and her late husband, Lee Wulff, lived in Swanzey and Surry, N.H. Lee dedicated his life to Atlantic salmon conservation.

Joan and Lee founded the Wulff School of Fly Fishing. A consultant to Royal Wulff Products and the R.L. Winston Rod Company, Joan has been honored for her promotion of the sport to women. In 2004, Joan was enshrined in the National Freshwater Fishing Hall of Fame.
